Vidya Vikas Mandal's Shree Damodar College of Commerce & Economics is one of the best-known colleges in Goa. The College began in 1973 with just the B.Com program, but has since added BCA, BBA(Financial Services) and M.Com to the list of programs available to students.

With holistic development of students as its primary goal, the College pushes for academic excellence while at the same time ensuring that students have adequate opportunities to shine in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

It is a constant refrain of industry that students have only theoretical, bookish knowledge, that their knowledge is outdated, they are not “job-ready”, and so on. Recognizing the huge industry-academia gap, the College has initiated regular lectures by guest faculty from industry, industrial visits, industry involvement in curriculum development, and so on. This year the teachers have identified some relevant add-on courses and ensured that every Final Year student enrolled for at least one such course.

The Career & Placement Cell of the College takes active interest in preparing the students for the world of work by arranging talks on various career options open to students, and organizing training sessions on soft skills such as oral and written communication, résumé-writing, appearing for interviews, personal grooming, workplace etiquette and so on.

The Board of Management of Vidya Vikas Mandal is doing everything in its power to support Shree Damodar College in its march towards excellence. We are making large investments in ICT and physical infrastructure. In the ICT field, we have upgraded from a 10 mbps leased line in 2015 to a 14 mbps leased line in 2016, the entire campus is wi-fi enabled, the College library has been transformed into a true resource centre... As regards physical infrastructure, last year the College added the Annexe building housing the canteen, computer laboratories and the Post-Graduate department classrooms ; the infrastructure is all set to grow exponentially with more classrooms, smart classrooms, a playground and sports equipment planned for the near future.

Enthused by the success of the First Placement Fair in February 2016, the College has decided to make the 2017 version bigger and better. My Hearty Congratulations to the College, the teachers and the students for this initiative. I am confident that this event is here to stay and I hope that in future the College invites outstation recruiters as well.

Vidya Vikas Mandal's Shree Damodar College of Commerce & Economics is one of the oldest and most reputed Colleges in Goa. The College offers three Undergraduate programs, viz. B.Com, BCA and BBA (Financial Services), one Postgraduate Program – M.Com, and three PhD programs – in Commerce, Management Studies and Economics – all affiliated to Goa University.

The College has excellent, top-notch faculty in all its programmes. Since the last few years, teachers are supplementing their lectures with a wide array of pedagogical tools, such as case studies, role plays, seminar presentations, videos, management games and so on in order to shift the classroom focus from teaching to effective learning. Recognizing the need for students to have some industry exposure, teachers regularly invite guest faculty to interact with the students, organize industry visits, arrange panel discussions on current topics and send students out for internships.

This year teachers have ensured that all Final Year students take up at least one add-on course, and students have chosen to complete a Certificate Course either in Tally, Personal Financial Planning or Leadership Skills and Managerial Effectiveness. The Final Year BCA students have all completed a Certificate course in website ecommerce; other courses include Digital Forensics, Android Development and Architectural Design. We are confident that these added skills will enhance their employability.

All faculty members have gone the extra mile and created e-content for all their courses. Besides the normal PowerPoint presentations, teachers have downloaded videos, expert lectures, and other resources to supplement their teaching and give students a more interactive classroom experience. In an effort to develop students' communication skills, teachers have adopted modes of internal assessment involving some non-written communication on the part of students. We are confident that these steps, combined with the personality development programmes and the add-on courses, will go a long way towards enhancing the employability of our students.

In February 2016, the College decided to hold a local placement fair for our graduating students. It has been our experience that local businesses, banks, insurance companies, etc. need graduates for various jobs in accountancy, sales, marketing and so on, and yet students are not able to find jobs after they graduate. The purpose of the placement fair was to bring prospective employers to the College and help them choose the most suitable candidates. For our students the benefits were obvious – employment opportunities at their doorstep. The success of 2016 has encouraged us to have such a Fair yet again, this time with more invitees from all over the State.

On behalf of the Management, staff and students, I congratulate the Career and Placement Cell for this initiative, and wish the Cell and our students, success in this venture.
