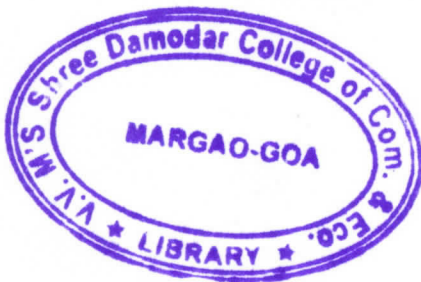

In his address Nitin Kunkolienker assured that he would procure the best mentor from the IT industry to guide faculty and students so as to equip them with latest trends in the industry.

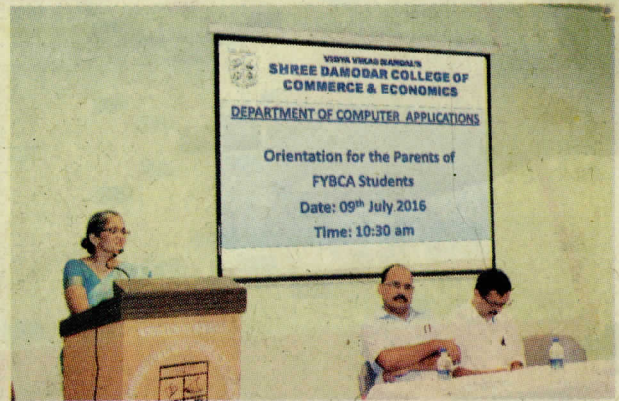
Programme co-ordinator, Ekta Agarwal shared highlights of BCA programme and further briefed parents regarding infrastructure, library and other facilities available.

session wherein parents shared their views, suggestions and also raised queries.



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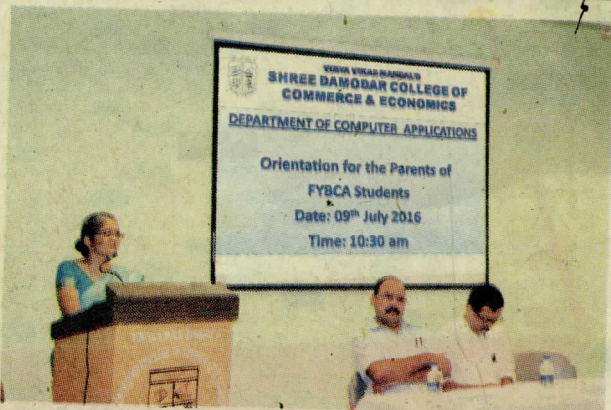

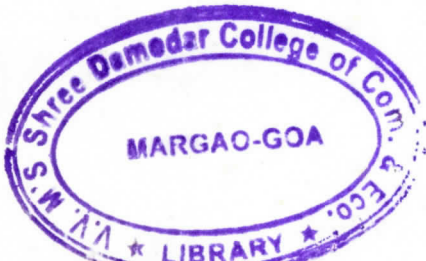

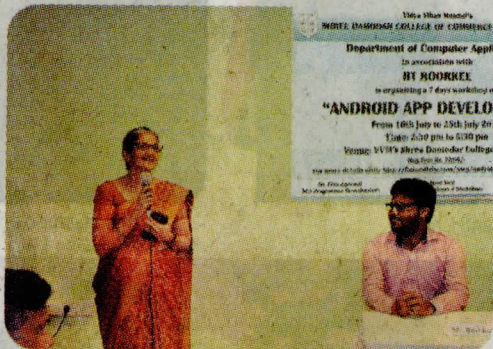
Workshop on Android Application Development

Addressing those present principal, Prita D Mallya highlighted the Digital India initiative by state and central governments in making all government services available for citizens through websites and how ability to access these online services would

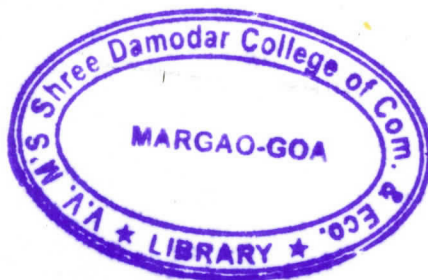


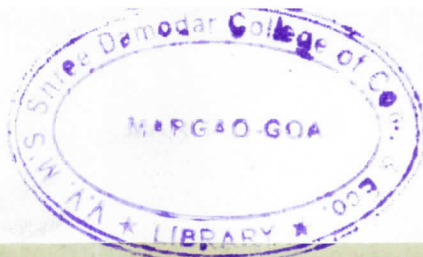
help ease of access and save time spent in queues.

The workshop provided hands-on experience to participants. Starting with basic services like online payment of utility bills, students made small presentations followed by

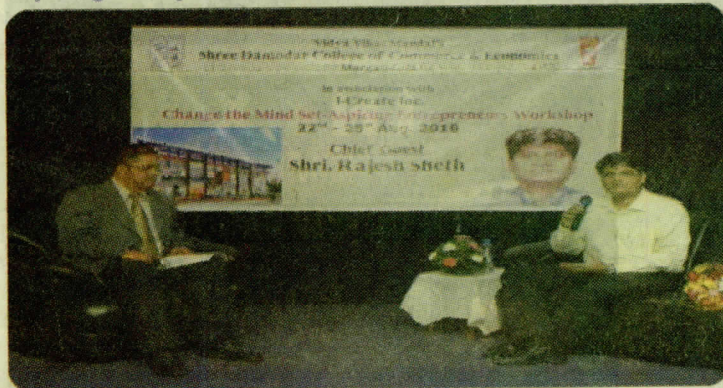

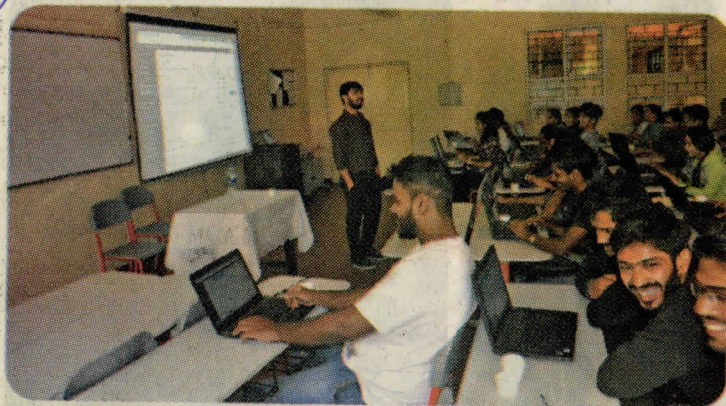
Some of the other activities held included an Ayurveda camp for

ipation and contribution to the cause of education in various educational forums and addressed the concerns of higher education in Goa.

Sahni emphasised that the entire teaching-learning mechanism needs to be revamped in order to match the changing mindset of the student community with the help of the technology. He emphasized that academicians need to reflect and reinvent the process of knowledge creation, dissemination, examination and assessment. The teaching learning

process should focus on the fundamental interests of an individual and the content should be tuned to the passion and aspiration of the learner.

The vice chancellor opined that reforms are needed in the existing education system, so as to give the learner the flexibility to decide the pace, the scheme and content of his interest. Teaching learning should promote peer to peer learning and knowledge sharing in active circles of interaction across different streams.



He added that the teaching community should be mentally equipped to deal with the changing demands of the learners and the availability of real time information. Teachers should be facilitators, to guide students through the learning process. Hence adaptability and flexibility should be the primary characteristics of a teacher. Sahni concluded by expressing his concern regarding the need to harness the latent knowledge that is not recognised in the society, which

needs to be included into formal education system.

Varun Sahni's speech was well received by students, faculty and all the invitees. Later he gave away trophies and certificates to all the achievers who brought laurels to the institution in academics, sports, cultural activities, NCC and NSS.

The program concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Edwin Baretto, Convenor, Students' Council, followed by the National Anthem.

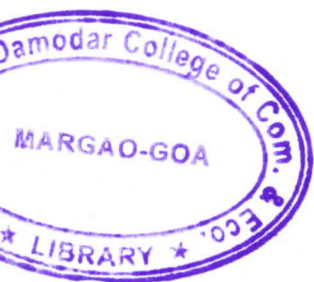

Workshop on Android Application Development

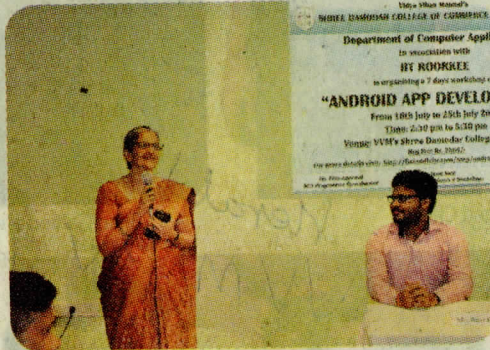
