
Parulekar dwelled on the fact that a multi-disciplinary approach to research would bring about incremental innovations as opposed to disruptive innova-





Three years after the only varsity in the state started to function independently, football helped occupy a pride of plac

University Football Championship in 1988. At the Prasad Stadium Margao, hosts personified both those characteristics in their opening game as Patna University were crushed with striker Roy Barreto in fine form


Inter-collegiate sports event Helios 1.0


