## a. For FY and SY Students

Semester-End Examination marks will be calculated (scaled up) based on the ISA marks and marks obtained in practical examinations.

## b. For TY Students

Semester-End Examinations will be conducted from July 1<sup>st</sup> onwards and ISA components are to be necessarily completed.

- 2) Students are advised to take all the ISAs seriously. Students should complete and submit their assignments as per the due/last date and instructions mentioned by the concerned subject teacher.
- 3) Teachers will not accept submissions beyond due/last date mentioned by the concerned teacher.
- 4) Teachers will not accept ISAs sent by Whatsapp or any such means. The ISA should be typed as a Word document (unless specifically mentioned otherwise by the teacher concerned) and sent by email or similar means (Google Classroom/ Fedena, if instructed by teacher) only.
- 5) No ISA will be accepted beyond May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Please note that the email shows the time it has been sent this will be the College record for rejecting late submissions after May 31<sup>st</sup> 2020.
- 6) All students may note that where an ISA is not received, the student will get **ZERO** marks for that ISA and the marks of the remaining completed ISA(s) will be considered for scaling up the marks to arrive at the Semester-End Examination marks.
- 7) Any student who fails, will then have to appear for the Supplementary examination of the said course.
- 8) Students are also informed that teachers will check submissions for "plagiarism / copy-paste" and marks will be deducted if "plagiarism / copy-paste" is detected.
