The idea for this Placement Fair came from the Internal Quality Assurance Cell, which observed that local businesses, banks, insurance companies, etc. need graduates for various jobs in accountancy, sales, marketing and so on; graduates need jobs and yet both sets of demands remain unsatisfied. The purpose of the Placement Fair is to bring prospective employers to the College and help them choose the most suitable candidates. For our students the benefits are obvious – employment opportunities at their doorstep.
