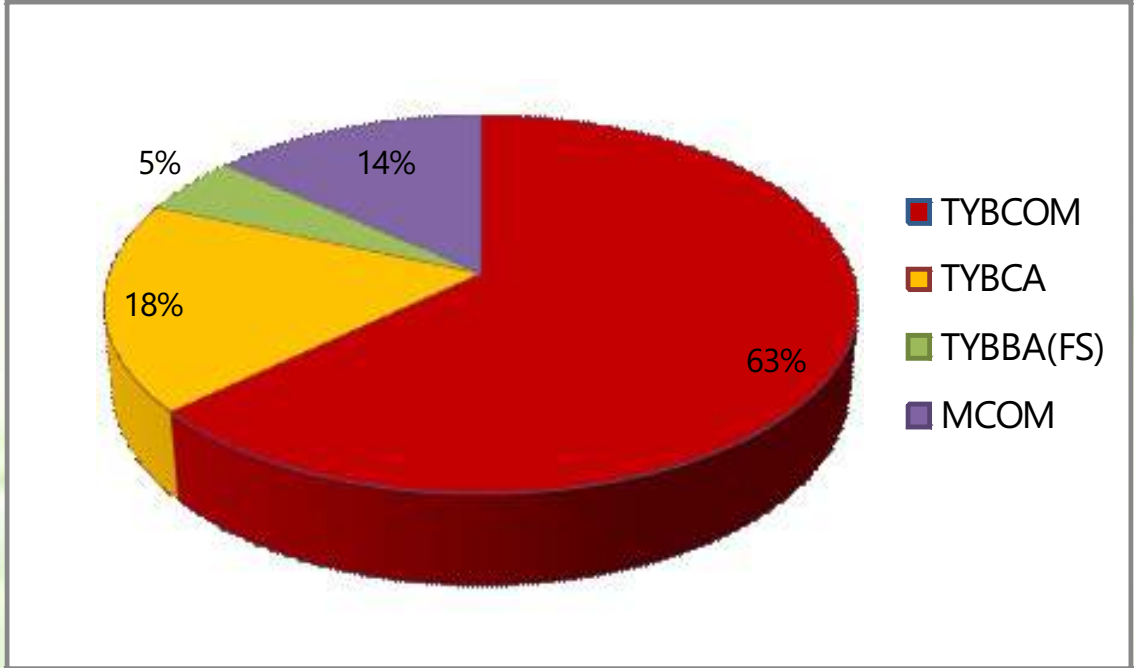

PROCEDURE FOR PLACEMENT PROGRAMME

The Process

- ✓ Recruiters are requested to fill the enclosed “Recruitment Registration Form (RRF)” and email or deposit it with Career & Placement Cell on or before 18th February 2016.
- ✓ By filling the RRF, the recruiter agrees to participate in the Local Placement Fair.
- ✓ Student Pre-Registration will start on 18th of February 2016 after the Recruiters Profiles are displayed in college.
- ✓ Interested students will fill in a Student's Registration Form and submit it to the Placement Cell with their résumé.
- ✓ The Registration with the companies may also be done on the day of recruitment i.e. 27th February 2016 from 09.00 am to 10.30 am at the recruiter's stall/space.
- ✓ The Selection Process shall start from 10.30 am onwards.
- ✓ Recruiters may, in accordance with their own policy, conduct a Recruitment Process of their preference: Interviews, Group Discussions, and Written Tests etc.
- ✓ Please note that the all Recruiters will be conducting the selection process simultaneously and it may happen that a particular candidate may opt for many companies. Keeping this in mind, Recruiter may conduct the selection process preferably in 3 slots (viz. 10.30 – 12.30, 01.00 – 03.00, and 03.30 – 05.30), if required.
- ✓ In the event that the process cannot be completed on the same day, the concerned Recruiter may continue on 29th of February 2016 from 9.30 a.m. until 1.00 p.m.
