

NOTICE

Based on Circular No. GU/Exam Div/2021/542, dated 14-06-2021 issued by Goa University, all **Regular and Repeat students of TY B.Com, BCA & BBA(FS)** are hereby informed that, with respect to **Semester VI** examinations

1. Examinations will commence from **July 9, 2021**
2. The Timetable will be displayed on the College website
3. Students will NOT visit the College to answer the examination
4. There will be only one Question Paper per subject for students of all divisions.
5. The duration of the examination shall be **two hours**.
6. The question papers shall be sent to the students by E-mail(^{from}to the College email-id) / WhatsApp.
7. The question paper will be sent at 10:00 a.m.
8. Students may either type the answers electronically or write down the answers and then scan/photograph and upload the answer sheet. Students will be required to upload their answer scripts **latest by 1:00 p.m.**
9. Students may please note that
 - a) **No answer script will be accepted after 1:00 p.m.** Students are advised to upload/send the answer script as soon as they finish answering and checking their answer scripts, so as to avoid issues of poor connectivity, etc.
 - b) The **scanned image / photograph should be clear and legible**; no marks will be assigned if the examiner is unable to read the answer script
 - c) **Detailed instructions regarding the examinations will be put up on the College website by July 5th** and students shall strictly follow the instructions.



The pattern of the question paper will be as follows:

B Com + B Com (Hons)

A) B.Com Programme (Semesters VI (Regular and Repeat), OC-66 (CBCS))

1. The examination for all subjects shall be of 30 marks.
2. There will be two types of questions.
 - a. Question No. 1 will have 8 questions of 2 marks each, of which students will answer any 5 questions.
 - b. Question No. 2 will have 6 questions of 5 marks each, of which the students will answer any 4 questions.

B) BCA Programme (Semesters VI, Regular and Repeat)

1. The examination for theory papers shall be of 30 marks.
2. There will be two types of questions for theory papers.
 - a. Question No. 1 will have 8 questions of 2 marks each, of which students will answer any 5 questions.
 - b. Question No. 2 will have 6 questions of 5 marks each, of which the students will answer any 4 questions.

**C) BBA(Financial Services) Programme
(Semesters VI, Regular and Repeat)**

1. The examination for all subjects shall be of 25 marks.
2. There will be two types of questions.
 - a. Question No. 1 will have 8 questions of 2 marks each, of which students will answer any 5 questions.
 - b. Question No. 2 will have 5 questions of 5 marks each, of which the students will answer any 3 questions.
