




95 First Year BCA and B.Voc.(Software Technologies) students attended the session through Google Meet.





Mr. Abhinav Apte, Founder, Track Change, was the original Resource Person. However, he as facing severe Internet problems, and his wife, Mrs. Apoorva Apte, Proprietor, Shubhankar Environmental Services took over as the resource person. Mrs. Apte, a reputed environmental enthusiast and conservationist, started her session by playing videos highlighting the garbage issue that is critically impacting the flora and fauna as well as causing deterioration in human health, by showcasing videos on the same. She stressed on the fact that waste management is the need of the hour and must be practiced by all. There were two parts to Ms. Apte's session.

The first part dealt with the organic waste management activity that can be practiced at home. Mrs. Apte explained







  You can interview the person who knows the medicinal value of a plant.
- Video should be of 2-4 minutes.
- No two Groups are not allowed to choose the same plant (Every group should select a Plant and inform on WA group as to avoid repeation.
- Try to submit the video in less MB. Not more than 20MB possibly. Try to reduce the video size by changing the pixel quality setting.
- The student should give use of medicinal plant.
- If any idea is taken from certain sources then it must be properly cited in the video to avoid plagiarism.
- No copyrighted materials (music, images, etc.) may be used unless you own the copyright or the owner gives the right to use the same.
- Use of light background music in the video and also video editing is allowed.
- If submitted video is found to be downloaded from the internet then wont be considered.
- The student also needs to show his/her face at least once in a video.
- · Student need to speak in respectful manner in the video.
- The video must be strictly a Formal one with proper dressing style.
- If any informal behavior is noticed in the video then the student will lose the marks.
- The video must not contain material that is obscene, defamatory, offensive or encourages conduct that would be considered a criminal offence or violates any law.
- Videos must be appropriate for viewing by the general public.
- By submitting a video, student agrees to allow teacher to use their videos for information and education purposes, at no cost.
- Student should make a video in an innovative manner and try to showcase their talent and ideas in best way.
- Link will be open on both the platforms.
- Student need to upload the video on any one platform. This is done to avoid last moment uploading issues.
- The link will automatically get close after the deadline. Therefore, students are expected to upload the videos on or before the date of submission.
- Follow all the instructions carefully.
- Following is the list of some medicinal plant. You can select one from them or can choose different topic which is not listed below.
- Local Names: Tlusi, Haldi, Ganjan, Durva, Bilvadal, avala, shatavari, alovera, ritha, (any other plant may be selected).



The main objective of the course was to enable the students to create and edit basic worksheets and workbooks. The course was designed for students who wanted to gain the necessary skills to create, edit, format the worksheets and get certified in using Advanced Excel. The topics that Mr. William Vaz covered during the course were:

- 2. Sales forecast, employee database, Advanced filters, What-if Analysis, Goal seek etc.

The speaker gave a conceptual and practical overview of the following topics:


- <u>Registration under the GST Act</u> <u>GSTIN</u>, Person(s) who are required to register under GST Act,

emotions and behavior. She then went on to focus on the causes of stress. The causes of stress, usually known as stressors, were explained in detail.


Before moving on, there was a short quiz held for all the participants to recapitulate the discussion so far. All the participants enthusiastically answered all the questions in the

The session concluded at 12:10 p.m.





# 15<sup>th</sup> May 2021


The Cultural Council of the College organized 'U. N. Bene Inter-Collegiate Quiz Competition' on May 15, 2021, from 08:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. through Google Meet platform. The theme of the competition was 'Incredible India!' Fourteen teams registered for the competition and Ten teams participated.

The competition commenced at 09:00 a.m. after the inaugural function at 08:30 a.m. At the inaugural function, Prof. Dr. Prita D. Mallya, Principal of Shree Damodar College welcomed the virtual gathering while Asst. Prof. Preksha Chopdekar briefed on the activities of the Cultural Council and introduced the Quiz Master, Mr. Suraj Kamat Founder, The Quiz Labs.

The competition was conducted in two rounds, viz. the preliminary round and the final round. The preliminary round had twenty-five questions, which participants had to answer within thirty minutes through a time-based Google Form. The link to the Google Form was mailed to the participants five minutes prior to the commencement of the preliminary round. Each participant answered the preliminary round individually. 


The resource person for the session was Mr. Suhas M. Mallya, Executive Director, Emco Goa Private Limited and an ex-student of the College


## **Day Two: 20th May 2021**

  - Problem categorization






