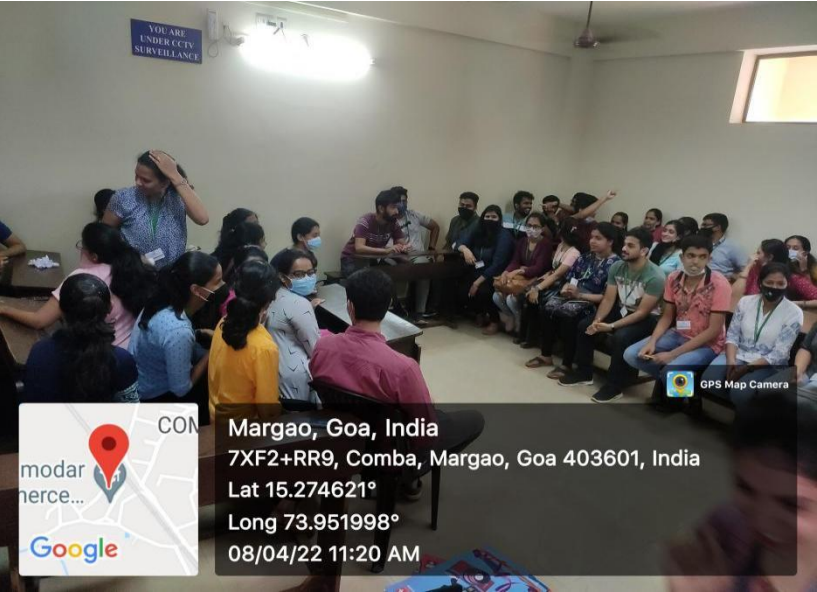

21st March 2022



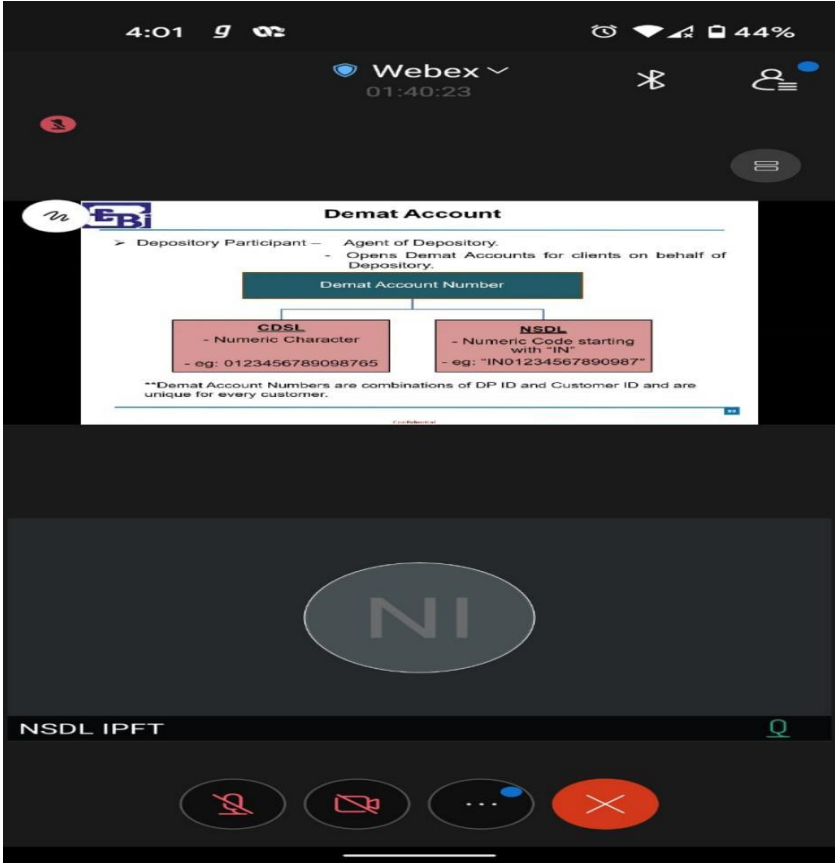

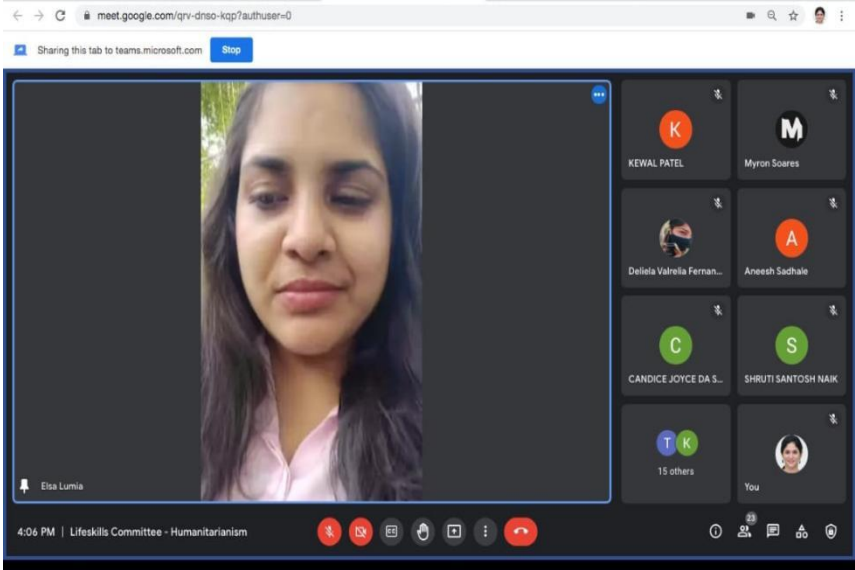
The Speakers for the session were Ms. Sonia Shah(AGM-SEBI), Ms. Heeral Shah(DM-NSE) and Mr. Sandeep Verma(AM-NSDL). The objective of the session was to create financial literacy and awareness amongst students on the practical operations of these three premier agencies. The session commenced with Ms. Sonia Shah discussing with students the three mandates of SEBI namely investor protection, development

promotion and regulation of stock exchanges. She briefed the students on the recent initiatives taken by SEBI towards investor protection and offered advice on the rights and responsibilities of an investor.

The second Speaker Ms. Heeral Shah explained in detail the operations with trading and settlement process of NSE. She made the students aware of the documents essential for trading and opening a Demat account. She also explained to them the process of placing an order for purchase/sale of equities on NSE. She ended her address by discussing with the students the investor grievance redressal mechanism of NSE. The last Speaker of the webinar was Mr. Sandeep Verma. He highlighted the services offered by NSDL and the securities transmission process. The session concluded with the Resource Persons addressing the queries of the participants. 52 students attended the Webinar.

Session on Humanitarianism

Prejudice on the basis of skin colour, gender, sexual orientation, ancestry, caste, class, occupation, illness, intelligence should be encouraged in any form.



The Career and Placement Cell in association with the Regional Employment Exchange, Office of Commission Labour and Employment, Government of Goa organised a session on National Career Service Portal and State Employment Exchange Registration on April 4, 2022, for the registered members of the Cell. The Resource Persons for the session were Ms. Deepa Dumatkar (Assitant Professor at Rosary College of Commerce and Arts) and Mr. Antony Afonso (Employment Officer Government of Goa)

Ms. Deepa Dumatkar began the session with a video on "3 Idiots." The message it conveyed was to "pursue your dream and do what you want." It also stated that students should focus on the positive aspects and avoid the negative aspects, as students tend to lose their confidence and it reflects their career. She highlighted that career development is not a single day task; it's an oceangoing process. SWOT analysis is another important aspect that was covered by the speaker, She said the students should know their strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and treats that would emerge in the future and take appropriate measures.

Ms. Antony Afonso employment officer gave briefing on the employment card registration. The process of application on Goa online portal (goaonline.gov.in) was demonstrated. He also logged in into the website and

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also specified the documents required for registration.

The session ended with a question and answer session at around 12:15 p.m. 82 students attended the session.

One Day State Level Workshop on “ Agriculture & Livelihood”

The Department of Economics of S.S Dempo College of Commerce and Economics, Bambolim Goa organized a One Day State Level Workshop on ‘Agriculture & Livelihood’ on 5th April, 2022. The objective of the workshop was to impart hands on knowledge on farming and modern developments and changes in recent years.

The workshop began with the Welcome Address by the Principal Dr. Radhika S. Nayak. Dr Amita Sanburg, Asst. Prof. introduced the speakers of the workshop. The first speaker, Dr Pradip Sarmokadam highlighted 4 dimensions of healthy living. He also spoke on the fact that indigenous seeds of different varieties of rice, pulses, vegetables and fruits are deteriorating inGoa. The State’s first brand “Govan” is helping the small and marginal farmers to restore the richness of our state.

Speakersfor second session was a young ‘agripreneur’ couple Mr. Vandit Naik and Mrs Priyanka Vandit Naik owner of “RasRaj” farms, Mollem. They shared their experiences of organic farming and how they have planned their farm. At the end of their session they gave a live demonstration of mango grafting and air layering.

The third speaker was Mr. Chinmay Tanshikar owner of organic spice farm and bee keeping at Sanguem. He highlighted the need of farming, also laid stress on cultivation of multi crops. He shared his experiences of vanilla cultivation.






The fourth speaker was Ms. Lizia Pinheiro who runs a consultancy firm “Fruits of Hardwork”. She provides services to people with respect to kitchen gardening. She in an inspiration to many as she promotes cultivation for the ones who have limited piece of land.

All speakers highlighted the importance of organic production and shared their experiences. The workshop was highly appreciated by the participants.

8th April 2022



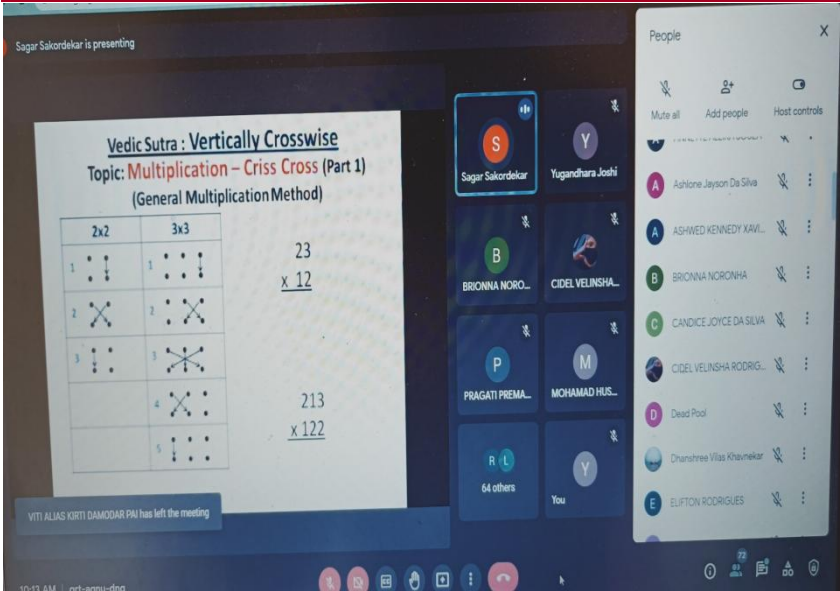

The Department of Economics & Banking in collaboration with the Faculty Development Cell of organized a session on “Understanding Goa Budget 2022 – 23” for its faculty, on the 11th of April 2022, in the Smart classroom of the College. The Resource Person for the session was Prof. Manoj S. Kamat, Principal of DPM’s Shree Mallikarjun and Shri Chetan Manju Desai College.

The session began with the Welcome Address delivered by Prof. Prita D. Mallya, Principal, stressing on the importance of keeping abreast of and understanding the budget. She applauded the Department of Economics & Banking and Faculty Development Cell for taking the initiative in organizing the session. This was followed by an introduction of the Resource Person by Asst. Prof. Ms. Lizette D’Costa, of the Department of Economics & Banking. As a welcoming gesture, the Resource Person was presented with a potted plant by the Vice-Principal of the College, Dr. Rodney D’Silva`.

Dr. Manoj Kamat began his session by enlightening the ways to comprehend a budget once it is presented. He said that it is not enough to merely read the budget speech, we have to go beyond, in understanding it. He emphasized the action taken report, which is also a key element. He spoke about the figures of three estimates, actual, budget, and revised. He stressed that if we want to thoroughly study the budget, it is of prime importance to compare the present budget with the previous, as well as the preceding to the previous year’s budget. He spoke about growth in lagging and new initiatives, fiscal deficit, RBI financing, expenditures, borrowings, and allocations of the government. Focusing on Goa Budget 2022-23, Dr. Kamat, highlighted vital figures like Goa’s current fiscal deficit of ₹ 3500 crores, public debt close to ₹ 21000 crores, and current borrowing of approximately ₹ 300 crores. He shared that he was pleased to see the aspects like education, manufacturing, employment generation, etc., given importance in the budget. He also highlighted the novelty focus on ease of doing business, however, was a bit disappointed that there was no specific discussion on the manufacturing sector which is considered to be the growth engine supporting economic growth. On the negative front, he highlighted that the budget did not talk about the implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) and a thumbs down for the industrial sector. Dr. Kamat accentuated that the discussion of the appropriation bill will provide a realistic view, and thereafter major corrections are bound to take place in one to two months. An advantage for the State government is that the same party rules the Central government.

He concluded with some take-home points, like, not looking only at the budget speech which is merely a melodramatic exercise. Intentions of the government are good, however, only if they are backed by financial provisions and realistic viewing of the budget is of prime importance.

Dr. Lira M. Gama, Head of the Department of Economics & Banking and Convenor of the Faculty Development Cell, proposed the Vote of Thanks. Ms. Simren Mascarenhas, student of SY B.Com was the compere for the session. 30 faculty members attended the session.

The session was Coordinated by Asst. Prof. Ms. Lizette D’Costa and Asst. Prof. Mr. Sanjay B. Velip, of the Department of Economics & Banking.

E-Quiz on Indian Economy

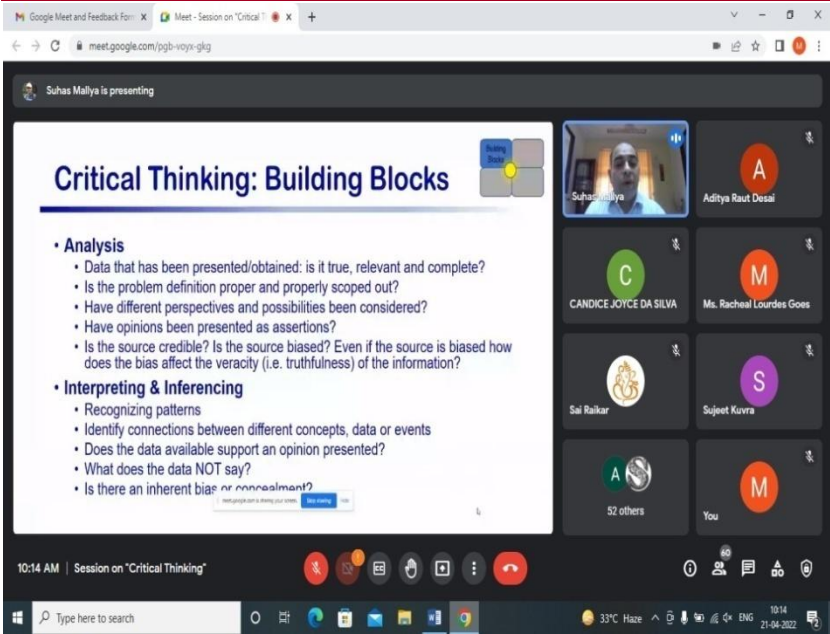
19th to 25th April 2022

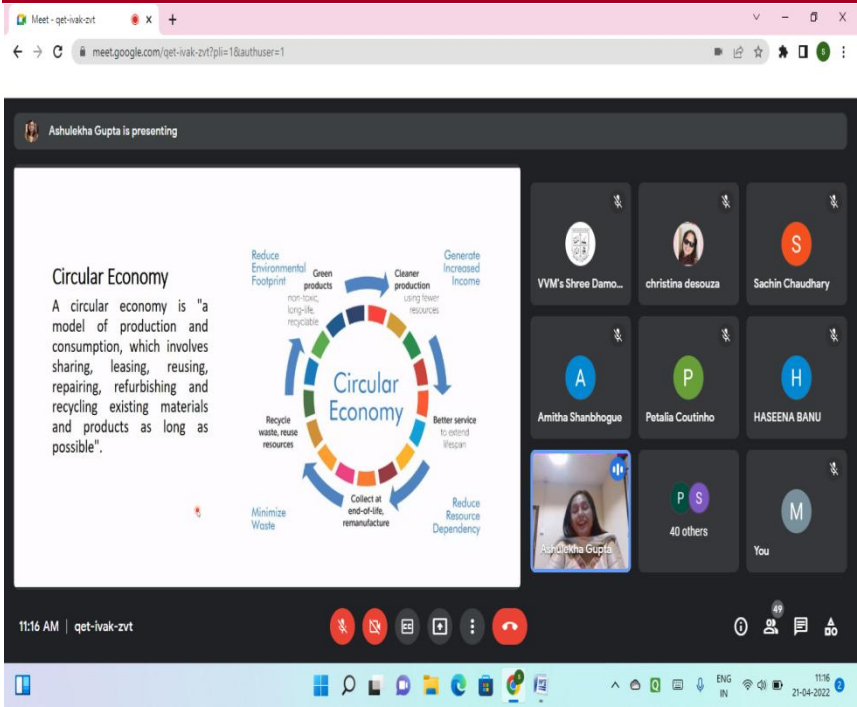
Director at Emco Goa Private Limited.

Ms. Petalia Coutinho was the compere for

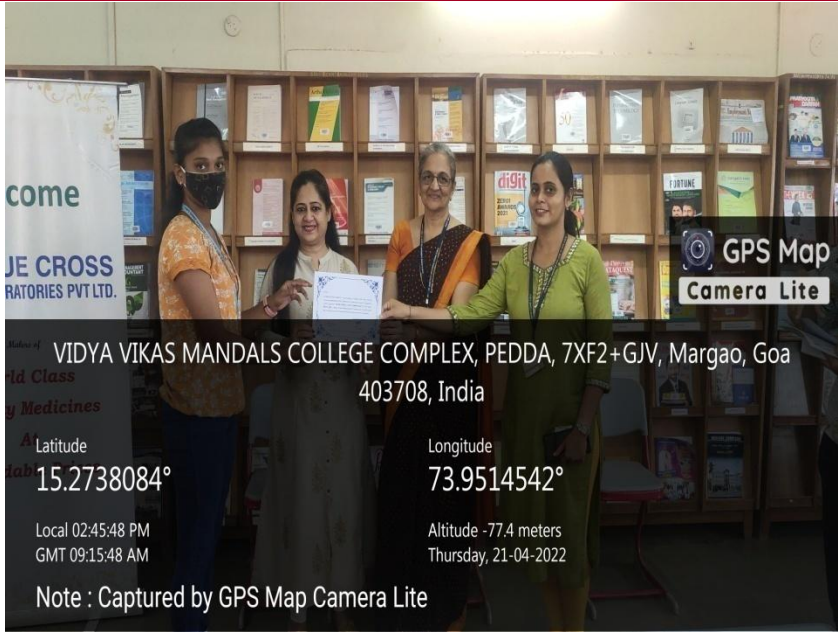

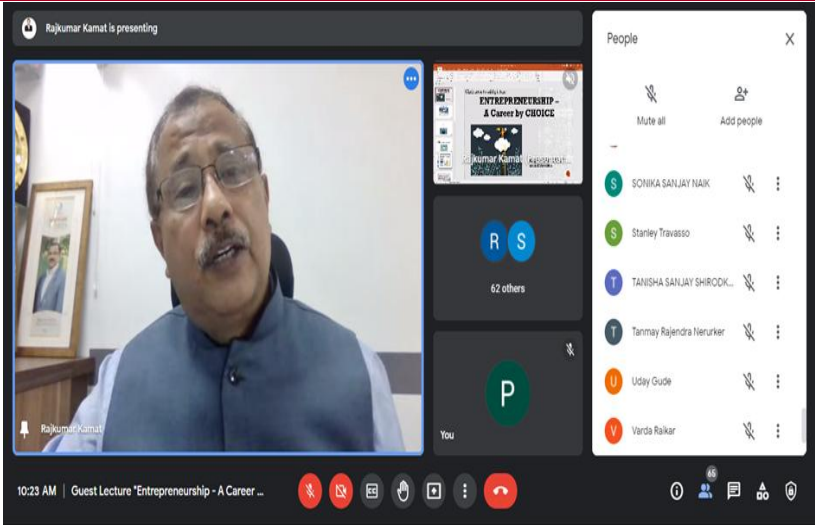

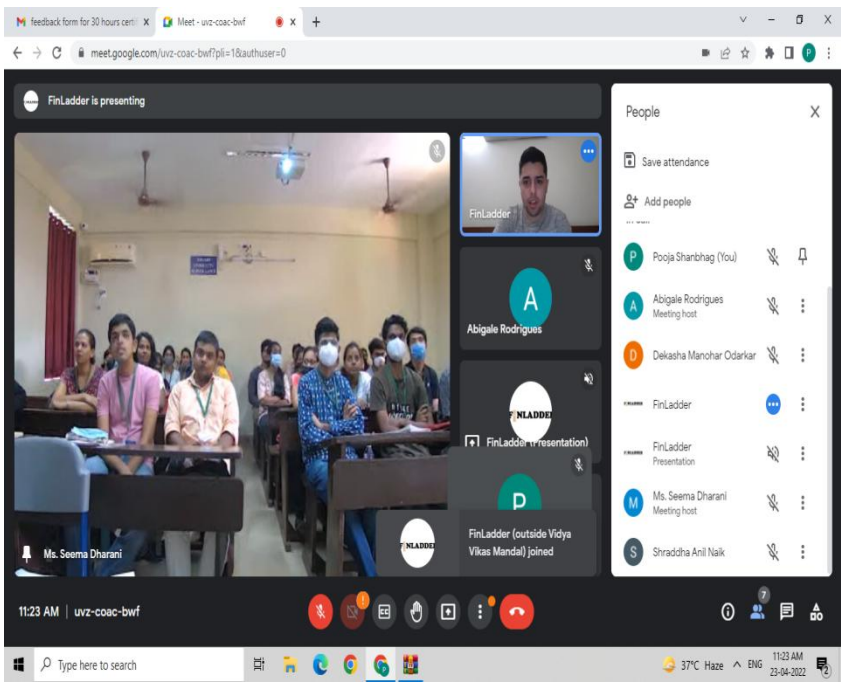
