Remedial classes/ Peer learning by Department of Computer Science





The Student Welfare Cell had organized Remedial classes for students of BCA and B.Voc(ST) programmes. Remedial classes were scheduled twice in the odd semester of the Academic year 2022-23. The first set of remedial classes was scheduled for FY BCA, SY BCA, TY BCA and FY B.Voc(ST) students prior to the ISA-1 from 25th August to 9th September 2022. 30 Hours Certificate Course on "Technical Analysis of Stocks"

6th to 28th October 2022

The Department of Management of the College conducted a certificate course on "Technical Analysis of Stocks" for TYBBA(FS) students. The Certificate course was conducted from 6th to 28th October 2022 from 2.30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. 48 students attended and completed the certificate course. The objective was to give practical exposure to Stock Trading and Portfolio Creation. The Resource Person for the certificate course was Mr. Mahadev Gadekar, Proprietor, Aarna Financial Services, who has worked with HDFC Bank for 6 years. He started his own venture "Aarna Financial Services" which offers services related to investing in stocks and mutual funds, risk planning, financial planning, loans and actively involved in educating the youth in the

subjects of investing and money management.

The syllabus for the certificate course was divided into 08 Modules. The topics covered were introduction about Technical Analysis, charting software, Reading and interpretation of charts, Trading strategies, Indicators and Oscillators, Trading Psychology and Risk Management. Investor Psychology in Stock was also covered under one Module. Students were shown Live Trading sessions along with creation of market stations, margin management, application of stop loss

and balancing of greed and fear in the stock market trading.

Students were asked to create dummy accounts for practice. Students created portfolio of stocks using Dalal Street Journal Application. The record of Buy and Sell transaction was maintained in excel workbook on daily basis. Every student had to select the stocks for Investment using technical Analysis.

The students actively participated and created dummy portfolios which gave them the practical exposure to the world of Technical Analysis. In the first session conducted on 7th October 2022, Mr. Punarva Prabhu Dessai explained about the dos and don'ts for taking physical care of the system. This included knowledge about charging, cleaning, hinges, shutting down, updates etc. He also informed how a system slows down and what we can do to prevent it. He further explained about better organization of folders, saving, passwords etc. He shared tips to name folders and files, so that anyone can locate documents in the absence of the dealing hand.

Ms. Pradnya Nadkarni conducted two sessions one on 11th & other on 18th October 2022 on how to use Gmail more efficiently. She covered topics like Type of Accounts, Main Menu Views, Organizing Inbox, Creating Labels, Search and Filter emails, Archive an email, Report as Spam, deleting email, Mark as unread, Snooze an email, Add email to task, Move to, Labelling email, Mark as important email, Star an email with different colours, Create an event, Mute an email, forward all email, Schedule email, Confidential email, Create email Template, Auto reply an email, Auto forward email, Vacation email, Un-send an email, Create email signature, Create email signature using free online signature generator, Email shortcut Keys, How to secure your email account and Email Etiquettes.

On 25th October & 1st November 2022, Ms. Pradnya conducted sessions on Google Workspace. During these two sessions, she covered topics like Google Drive: Create folder, folder sharing, upload files, file sharing and collaborating, organize your files, creating files, Google Docs, Google Sheets, Google Slides, Creating Templates, and Google Contacts. She also demonstrated Creating forms, Creating Quiz, Google Calendar: Creating Events and Task, Setup New Calendar, Sharing Calendar etc.

On 14th October 2022, Ms. Usha Gauncar conducted a session on WPS Writer -Text formatting, alignment, Font, Paragraph & line spacing, Bullets & numbering, Find & replace, format painter, Inserting header, footer, page border, page colour, watermark, Views, Page setup for printing, page break and Template.

On 21st October 2022, Ms. Usha covered topics such as WPS Writer & Presentation - Insert objects like picture, table, shapes, WPS art and their formatting, insert text from file, insert file object, Word count, thesaurus, export to PDF, Creation of slides, formatting, slide design, Animation and transitions, Views and slideshow.

On 28th October and 4th November 2022, Ms. Usha covered topics such as WPS Spreadsheet -Referencing (absolute, relative, mixed), Simple formula (sum, count, max, min...), Auto filter and advanced filters, Pivot table for data analysis, VLOOKUP formula, Date functions, If formula, Subtotal, Conditional formatting and Sorting.

The 9-Day ICT workshop was coordinated by Dr. Lina Sadekar, IQAC Coordinator.

"Primary and Secondary Data Analysis"

13th, 14th, 15th October & 4th November 2022

The PG Department of Commerce organized a workshop on 'Primary and Secondary Data Analysis' on 13th, 14th, 15th October and 4th November 2022 to provide practical training to the students on data analysis using various statistical techniques and software thereby helping the students in analyzing data in dissertation. The Workshop was conducted over four days by inviting faculty members having expertise in various statistical techniques and software.

The first two sessions were held on 13th and 14th October 2022 from 12:15 to 1:15 pm in Room No.T-302.

The Resource Person for these two days sessions was Mr. Gajanan Haldankar, Assistant Professor in Commerce from the Department of Commerce of the College. Mr. Gajanan delivered a session on how to analyze primary data using Jammovi software. On Day 1, the session started with a welcome note and a brief introduction of the Resource Person by Asst. Prof. Twinkle Fernandes. Thereafter, Mr. Gajanan started the session by giving a brief overview on research along with the steps of research process. Thereafter, he guided the students on how to download the Jammovi software. He also explained the various types of variables, measurement scales, parametric and non-parametric tests. On Day 2, Mr. Gajanan demonstrated on how to prepare a questionnaire using Google forms, followed by necessary guidance to download the responses and transfer the data from excel to Jammovi software using coding. Thereafter he explained in detail how to analyze the data using Descriptive statistics and Chi-Square test. The session concluded at 1.30 pm with a Vote of Thanks proposed by Mr. Anand Kumar.

The third session of the workshop was held on 15th October 2022 in Room No. F-101 from 9:00 am to 1:30 pm. The Resource Person for this session was Dr. Dhaneesh Kumar, Assistant Professor in Economics, Dnyanprasarak Mandal's College and Research Centre, Assagao. Dr. Dhaneesh delivered a session on how to analyze secondary data using Gretl software. The session started with a welcome note by Asst. Prof. Valencia Baptista and a brief introduction of the Resource Person by Ms. Kanak Indoria. Dr. Dhaneesh commenced the session by giving a brief overview of secondary data analysis. Thereafter, he explained meaning, uses and methodology of Econometrics; Descriptive Statistics; CLRM Assumptions, Coefficient of Determination, Adjusted R, Hypothesis testing and Linear Regression Models. He also provided clarity in these concepts by doing practical computations using Gretl Software. The session concluded at 1.40 pm with a Vote of Thanks proposed by Ms. Vanessa Carasco.

The fourth session of the workshop was held on 4th November 2022 in Room No. T-302 from 9:00 am to 1:30 pm. The Resource Person for this session was Dr. Harip Khanapuri, Associate Professor in Commerce, Goa Business School, Goa University. Dr. Harip delivered a session on how to analyze secondary data using E-Views software. The session started with a welcome note by Asst. Prof. Valencia Baptista and a brief introduction of the Resource Person by Ms. Jyoti Kumar. Dr. Harip commenced the session by defining the term econometrics, its uses and its impact on the modeling equation and correction i.e., Vector Auto Regression (VAR) model and Volatility model. He also demonstrated how to test stationarity, lag length, stability, auto correction, mean, variance, impulse response, Augmented Dickey test using the examples of stock market in E-

Views software. The practical aspects were supported by theory with respect to the role, usage, relation, outcome, criteria to accept or reject hypothesis and correlation model. The session concluded at 1.30 pm with a Vote of Thanks proposed by Mr. Anand Kumar.

The sessions were very informative and interactive and the Resource Persons were also helpful in solving the queries of the students. It was an effective session, as the students of M. Com Part II will be able to utilize these statistical skills for the interpretation of the data in their dissertation. 26 students attended the workshop.

The objective of the field trip was to provide students with practical exposure and experience of the process and techniques of retailing in rural markets and to understand how it is different from marketing in urban areas.

The students gathered in the College campus and

Dr. Rodney D'Silva, teacher incharge of the activity welcomed the students and gave them details about the itinerary and timings. The bus left at 8.00 a.m. from the College premises. The first destination was Banastari local market. Since local markets are the essence of Indian economy, the students were given an exposure to the marketing activities in rural areas. They observed the marketing pattern and techniques keeping in mind pricing strategies, lot size, product quality, etc. The local market was flooded with Goan local products like spices, vegetables, groceries, handmade artifacts, pottery items, handmade jewellery, coconut and coconut products, etc. The students enthusiastically asked questions to the local vendors in order to learn more about their marketing patterns.

The next destination was Mapusa Friday Local Market. Mapusa Friday Local Market is well known for its speciality of the Goans to open up stalls to sell their local homemade products. The students went on a shopping trip in this market with a motive of understanding various concepts of rural marketing learnt in the theory classes on campus. Dr. Rodney D'Silva reminded the students about the various concepts they have been taught as a part of syllabus and guided them on how to relate the same in practice. Students were provided with an hour to explore the market and make observations on their own.

The third destination was Mall de Goa, Porvorim. The students were taken to the mall to understand the difference between rural and urban marketing. The TY B.Com students observed the retail stores at the mall pertaining to convincing power of the storekeepers towards the customers, pricing patterns, marketing strategies, branding, etc. The students actively took part in this learning process. attended the session.



Session on "Cyber Wellness" by Counseling Cell in association with IQAC

2nd November 2022



The Counseling Cell in association with the IQAC organized a session on 'Cyber Wellness' on 02nd November 2022. The Resource Person for the session was Ms. Sonal Naik, Trainer at Cyber Wellness Centre, Panaji-Goa. A total of 59 students attended the session.

The objective of the session was to create awareness on cyber safety and responsible online behaviour among students. College Counselor, Ms. Eshani Bakhle and faculty member Asst. Prof. Myron Pereira coordinated the session.

Ms. Sonal commenced the session by explaining various cybercrimes such as photo morphing, stalking, sharing fake news, cyber bullying, creating fake accounts of others and hacking. She described the legal consequences of the same to the students. While speaking about cybercrimes, Ms. Sonal provided the audience with examples of real-life events. The concept of sextortion, revenge porn and porn addiction were also explained to the students.

Thereafter, she informed the students about safety measures and reporting mechanism for online gaming and social media platforms. The safety measures with regards to social media included not sharing live videos or photos that would disclose one's live location, gathering evidence in case of crime such as taking screenshots, reporting it on social media platforms and informing the concerned authority about the same. For safe online gaming, the students were informed to not join gaming groups or people they are unaware of and not to buy gaming items online without proper information.

Lastly, she spoke about the mental health aspects of individuals who have been victims of cybercrimes. Ms. Sonal concluded the session by informing them about the functioning of Cyber Wellness Centre located in Goa. Advanced learners were identified by the mentors and were guided to engage remedial sessions. This provided the students with an opportunity to engage in peer learning. A separate schedule / timetable was prepared and the details of the same were shared with the students in advance.



3rd November 2022





Thereafter, he explained the difference between Value and Price, he also explained why there is a need for valuation and where valuation is most important. He informed that Valuation is used in Capital Budgeting, Litigation, Investment, Mergers and Acquisitions.

CA. Pankaj discussed the Facebook vs. WhatsApp Deal, wherein he mentioned to the students how Facebook bought WhatsApp for USD 19 million in 2014because the user base of WhatsApp was more than 2 billion users outside US; besides this WhatsApp also had a technological edge over Facebook which Facebook feared. He further discussed the Zomato and ADONMO acquisition in 2021 wherein Zomato acquired 19.4% stake for Rs.112 crore.

CA. Kakode further explained about the application of valuation approaches for Valuation of Bonds and Derivatives.

The session was very informative and helped the students in understanding the various practicalities of Corporate Valuation. Students raised various queries, which the Resource Person answered. The session ended at 12:30 p.m. and Ms. Neebha Ghodge from M.Com-II proposed the Vote of Thanks. 61 M.Com students attended the session along with the Vice Principal and faculty members from the M.Com Department and the Alumni Engagement Cell.



The PG Department of Commerce organized a session on 'Creative Advertising- A for Idea' on 14th November 2022. The Resource Person for the session was Mr. Prasad Deshpande, Co-Founder & Creative Director at Goa Bylane. A total of 51 M.Com students attended.

Mr. Deshpande commenced the session with a display of his biodata in a creative way and spoke about his working experience. Thereafter, he explained how to develop ideas and covered aspects like thinking different, anatomy of an Idea, and how to make ideas useful to clients. He elaborated upon what constitutes an idea - it may be a visual, thought, piece of image, music, or painting. Then he went on to explain the key points of difference between innovation, invention and discovery.

Mr. Deshpande played an old advertisement of Honda to explain how the sound of car can be visualized and in a unique manner made into an adfilm. He surprised the students by stating that "it is important to awaken the thief in you" - by this he meant we can take ideas from various sources. We have always thought that a coin has two sides, but students were amazed when Mr. Deshpande said that "every coin has three sides", he cited various examples to justify his statement. He posed three questions to support his points. What do clients want? What do customers perceive? And what do we interpret as an ideation?

Mr. Prasad also discussed about how and where to begin with the process of ideation, and covered the various steps to be followed in the ideation process. Mr. Prasad spoke about 'rules to break rules' by thinking out of the box. Mr. Prasad went on to explain how to sell a washing machine using tube lights, by which he meant that one should explore beyond the conventional sources. He suggested ways to achieve this by thinking rapidly, knowing the product well and not repeating it. Mr. Deshpande addressed questions from the audience.

The Vote of Thanks was proposed by Yash Prabhu student of M.Com-II (Business Management).

through exposure to new thoughts and ideas.

The topic of the Master Class Series Lecture was "The Dawn of Space Exploration" by Dr. James Rhoads and Dr. Sangeeta Malhotra, Astronomers at NASA Goddard Space Flight Centre, USA.

Dr. Sangeeta commenced with the first session on Infrared Eyes on the Cosmic Dawn. She spoke about astronomy, galaxies and infrared light. She explained about Webb specialization in infrared light and shared her

experiences and learnings from various projects she has worked on. She said that galaxy seems to be moving away i.e. space stretches and as light travels, it stretches even more. She mentioned that they are trying to find about Green Peas i.e. local versions of primordial galaxies. She also explained about JWST Telescope. She summarized her session mentioning that JWST is exceeding expectations for finding galaxies at the dawn of light. They are building a wide field mission in the infrared.

The second session was on 'The dawn of Space exploration or perhaps Space exploration of cosmic dawn' by Dr. James Rhoads. He spoke on exploration that is enabled by new tools. He also said that they can explore the moon on Mars by sending a space probe but other galaxies are too far away to visit, hence they explore them using telescopes. He covered the various functions of telescope and focused on explaining about the Roman Space Telescope which is expected to be launched in 2026.

The master class series was attended by Dr. Sheetal Arondekar, Mr. Ajinkya Kudtarkar, Mr. Gajanan Haldankar, Mr. Ramkrishna Reddy and Ms. Swati Bhat.



He discussed a variety of points related to the education sector, firstly he pointed out that there is lack of connect between entrepreneurship mind and industry and there should be a strong foundation for the same in college education. He further said that school education can be improved by introducing the concept of buddy education, wherein college students will help school students to grow and achieve their goals. He was also of the opinion that education curriculum has to change on regular basis and new concepts like AI, Coding etc. has to be introduced in the syllabus. He said that the mindset of students should be changed from Job seekers to Job givers. The inaugural session concluded at 12.30 p.m.

The panel discussion started at 1.00 pm. The moderator of the discussion was Mr. Vishal Khurma, CEO, Woxsen University, Hyderabad. The other panelists were Dr. Ram Karan Singh, VC, ICFAI Dehradun, Dr. S V Ramana Rao, Director, Siva Sivani Institute of Management, Secunderabad, Dr. Suresh DS, Director, CIT, Gubbi and Dr. Venu Gopal Rao, Professor. The session started with the question on how technology can have an interplay in HE and NEP. Dr. Ram Karan Singh said that since India is a vast country we need to integrate and have an interdisciplinary approach and have University industry linkage; also education should move towards sustainability. Dr. Suresh DS said that physical infrastructure requirement will be greatly reduced however individuals have to be tech-savvy, GER will increase with use of technology. He further added that the best practices of their institute are to have all journals on single platform online for all students to browse, setting up of virtual labs. Dr. Venugopal said that the soul of NEP is to bring the best of potential in all students, however the challenge lies in change management, adapting to technology, frequently changing curriculum etc. Dr. Ramana Rao said we need to find the weak and bright students and try to bridge the gap between them, give grades based on their participation in class. The panel discussion ended at around 2.30 p.m.


