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Dissertation Orientation for M.Com Part II students

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8th April 2023

The Post Graduate Department of Commerce conducted an orientation session on Dissertation for the M.Com Part II students on April 8th, 2023. The primary purpose of this orientation was to introduce and familiarize the students with the concept and requirements of writing a dissertation.

Ms. Edrea Picardo, the Examination-in-Charge of the Department, conducted the orientation session. Ms. Picardo informed the students that the dissertation carries 16 credits, equivalent to 4 subjects, and will be graded for 400 marks. Each student will be assigned a guide who will provide guidance

throughout the dissertation process. The students were instructed to finalize their dissertation topics by September to ensure sufficient time for research and writing.

Ms. Picardo emphasized the importance of originality in research and academic writing. Students were instructed to duly acknowledge all sources used in their dissertation to maintain academic integrity. They were given insights into the structure of a research report, which typically includes sections on research methodology, data analysis, findings, and conclusion. Students were informed that they must submit both a soft copy and hard copy of their dissertation at least a week before the end of semester 4. The scheme of examination was explained, consisting of different components i.e. Research conceptualization (ISA I) carried 100 marks, Data Management (ISA II) carried 100 marks, and Submission of Dissertation Report and Final Report Presentation (End semester assessment) carried 200 marks. The students were informed about the upcoming Research Workshops, which will provide valuable guidance and support in data collection and analysis, further assisting them in their research endeavors.

Overall, the orientation session effectively provided the students with essential information and guidelines to undertake their dissertation research successfully. A total of 40 students attended the same.

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Library Orientation for First Year Students of all Programmes

26th June to 7th July 2023



The Department of Library and Information Science conducted a comprehensive Library Orientation session for all First Year students from 26th June to 7th July 2023. A total of 301 students were oriented across all programmes. This session aimed familiarize the students with various library and e-resources. During orientation, students were introduced to the library and its basic services. They were informed about the Library's working hours and the different sections it comprises. Detailed information was provided about the

vast collection of books and resources available in the library, including periodicals, magazines, and newspapers that are regularly subscribed to. In addition to the physical resources, students were also made aware of the range of Library services and facilities offered. This included topics such as borrowing rights, overdue charges (library fines), book location and retrieval methods, and the use of the Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC). The orientation covered essential Library rules and guidelines, as well as the various ICT-enabled services available, such as utilizing QR codes for accessing library services.

Furthermore, students were educated about accessing electronic resources through the Library. Once registered with the Library, students gained open access to a variety of e-resources such as Indiastat, N-LIST, and NDLI. These resources encompassed e-books, e-journals, e-papers, and other materials that could greatly support their studies, research, and references. Students were instructed on how to log in using their user IDs and passwords to fully utilize these digital resources.

Investor Hub Activity 2

1st July 2023

The Department of Management Studies organized an Investor Hub activity on Saturday, July 1, 2023. The first activity was "Three Truths Two Lies" which commenced at 11:30 am in the F 403 class. Notably, the students were informed that all Counseling sessions provided by the College are offered free of cost, ensuring accessibility to the necessary help and guidance.

Orientation Session on MOOCs - SWAYAM



15th July 2023

The Post Graduate Department of Commerce organized an Orientation on MOOCs – SWAYAM on 15th July 2023 between 12:00 noon to 12:30 p.m in classroom T-304. The main objective of the session was to give insights to students on SWAYAM, a platform for Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) initiated by Government of India.

Learning for Young Aspiring Minds.' She emphasized the three fundamental principles of SWAYAM, namely Access, Equity, and Quality, highlighting how this platform aims to ensure equal access to quality education for all, bridging the digital divide. She also briefly explained the term SWAYAM PRABHA. During the session, Ms. Twinkle delved into the regulatory frameworks governing SWAYAM, as well as the roles of National Coordinators and Sectors involved in managing and facilitating the platform's operations. She elaborated on the different agencies involved in this initiative and emphasized SWAYAM's holistic approach, which is based on a four-quadrant model.

Ms. Twinkle then went on to explain the SWAYAM certification process, offering insights into how learners can earn certifications upon completing courses. She demonstrated the functioning of the SWAYAM Portal onscreen, giving students a glimpse of the user interface and its interactive features. In terms of course duration, Ms. Twinkle informed the students that courses on SWAYAM typically span from 3 to 12 weeks, accommodating various levels of engagement based on the learners' preferences and time commitments.

Furthermore, she highlighted the availability of both Credit and Non-Credit course certificates for participants. Students who achieve a minimum score of 75% can opt for certification by paying a nominal fee, adding value to their academic accomplishments.

In the end, the students cleared their doubts on various aspects of SWAYAM platform. 40 PG students attended the session.


Constituency.

mark this momentous day, the College united 17 enthusiastic students, comprising 9 girls and 8 boys, who participated wholeheartedly in the Poster Competition.




