Completion of PRCN Course



15th May to 12th August 2023

OTA (Officers Training Academy, Gwalior) organized a PRCN (Pre-Commissioned Course) 110, GCI-36 from 15th May to 12th August 2023. 117 NCC trainee officers from Army and Navy from all over India attended the course. The primary objective of the course was to provide training to Assistant Nautical Officers (ANOs) and Girl Cadet Instructors (GCIs) in fundamental defenserelated subjects. These trained ANOs and GCIs would then go on to train cadets in their respective institutions.


The course spanned a total of 90 days, divided into two terms. At the conclusion of each term, examinations were conducted, and regular assessments were carried out. The rigorous training curriculum encompassed various activities, including drill exercises, physical training, yoga, leadership and personality development sessions, community development, and disaster management classes. Additionally, trainees participated in visits to notable places such as the Air Force Station in Gwalior, 97 Field Regiment of Artillery, 20 Grenadiers, Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education, 3 MP Naval Unit, and Tigra Dam. The course was further divided into two parts: a common syllabus and specialized subjects for the Army and Navy. Specialized subjects included map reading, boat pulling and rigging, semaphore language, and firing exercises. A typical day during the course began with yoga or exercise sessions, followed by activities like Zumba and aerobics. The day included drill exercises, lectures, and ended with more drill exercises and games.

During the mid-term break, trainees embarked on an educational tour to Agra, where they visited iconic landmarks such as the Taj Mahal and Red Fort. Towards the end of the course, another educational visit took place, covering historical sites in Gwalior, including Gwalior Fort, Saas Bahu Temple, Sun Temple, Gurudwara Data Bandi Chhor Sahib, Maan Singh Palace, Gujari Mahal, and Teli Ka Mandir. The course also included special events such as a dinner night with the Commandant and other officers at OTA, a high tea gathering at the Commandant's House, and a Passing Out Parade (POP) dinner night with Reviewing Officer Surgeon Vice Admiral of Navy Medical Services Arti Sarin.

Asst. Professor Ms. Pretty Pereira, NCC(Navy) Officer from the College attended and completed this course successfully.

30-Hour Certificate Course in "Trading Insights: Analyzing Price Movements in Financial Markets"

4th August to 6th September 2023



The SY & TY Certificate Course Committee in collaboration with the Department of Management Studies and TIP Cell organised a 30-hour Certificate course in "Trading Insights: Analyzing Price Movements in Financial Markets" from 4th August to 6th September 2023. This course aimed to equip students with the knowledge and skills necessary for understanding and analyzing price movements in financial markets. The Resource Person was Mr. Mahadev Gadekar, Proprietor, Aarna Financial Services.

The course commenced with a comprehensive introduction to technical analysis, laying the foundation for understanding price movements and market trends. Students learned to interpret historical price data, patterns, and trends, which are fundamental to technical analysis. Mr. Gadekar shared his valuable real-life experiences of trading with the students.

The course covered a wide range of topics in technical analysis and trading psychology, ultimately empowering students to make informed decisions in trading and investing. One of the key components of technical analysis, candlestick chart patterns, was thoroughly explained and demonstrated. Students gained insights into how to interpret and use candlestick patterns to make trading decisions. The course provided students with the tools and techniques needed to classify and identify different types of trends in financial markets. The utilization of technical indicators to assess market conditions and forecast price movements was explored. To reinforce the theoretical concepts, practical sessions were an integral part of the course. Students had the opportunity to apply their knowledge by creating dummy portfolios and practicing trading strategies. These hands-on exercises allowed students to gain valuable experience in trading within the stock market.

This course has equipped students with the tools to make informed decisions in the dynamic world of financial markets, ultimately contributing to their financial literacy and career readiness. 64 students of SY and TY B.Com &BBA(FS) attended the course.

The renowned Resource Persons for the session were Mr. Ritwik Korgaokar, a cyber security specialist and founder of Code Hack; and Mr. Riyaz Imran Khadri, CEO of Avanteia, a Cyber security Specialist, a Blockchain Specialist and a Faculty member at Sridora Caculo College of Commerce &

Management Studies, Mapusa. The primary objective of the session was to educate participants about the importance of cyber security in today's digital age. It aimed to raise awareness about the threats in cyberspace, preventive measures, and how to respond to security incidents effectively.

The session commenced with an introduction to the fundamental concepts of cyber security. The Resource Persons demonstrated real-life cyber security attacks carried out over the internet using various apps and techniques. 
The competition was held online and the last date of submission was 2nd September 2023.

Students were taught the basic, essential skills of holding, cutting, carving, and smoothening of thermocol, necessary for the best outcome of the decor. 3. Cooking and Baking essentials – 04th, 6th to 09th September 2023:

Mrs. Maria Lourdes Barreto was the Resource Person for the skill in cooking and baking essentials. Mrs. Barreto has a degree in Home Science, with an extremely deep passion for cooking and baking. During her

Data Scientist Career Path in Banking

Later, between 2019 and 2021, he pursued a master's degree in financial mathematics from the University of London.

The turning point in his life came when he received advice to explore opportunities in the finance sector. He decided to join an insurance company, where he embarked on a journey of personal and professional growth, eventually reaching the position of an analyst developer. During the session, Mr. Menon imparted motivational wisdom, emphasizing the significance of embracing both success and failure in life. He encouraged students to maintain a positive and joyful attitude regardless of external circumstances, drawing inspiration from Nelson Mandela's quote, "Do not judge me by my success, judge me by how many times I fell down and got back up."

Mr. Menon delved into various aspects of the banking sector, particularly the role of Information Technology in finance and investment procedures. He explained how Data Science is instrumental in the banking system, elucidating the sources of data collection for analysis, including stock market data for profit and loss assessments. He highlighted the interdisciplinary nature of Data Science in banking, which incorporates mathematical concepts, statistics, algorithms, computer science, and domain expertise. To illustrate this, he presented a Venn diagram depicting different facets of Data Science within the banking domain.

The Solid Waste Management Facility stands as a unique and pioneering integrated facility in the country. This remarkable facility serves as a critical hub for managing waste in a scientific and environmentally responsible

manner, primarily receiving waste from the northern coastal belt village panchayats. During the educational visit, the students were treated to a short documentary shedding light on the operations of the Goa Waste Management Corporation, providing an overview of its role and mission in sustainable waste management.

The tour then led the students to the dry and wet waste processing units, where they had the opportunity to witness firsthand the intricate processes involved in waste collection, segregation, and processing. The facility is well-equipped with state-of-the-art machinery, ensuring efficient and effective waste management. Impressively, the facility processes a substantial 250 tonnes of waste daily. This waste is meticulously transformed into compost fertilizer, which is subsequently made available to local farmers at fair prices, contributing to sustainable agriculture practices. Additionally, the facility harnesses biogas from the collected wet waste, putting it to use in the facility's kitchen operations.

The Wastewater generated during the waste treatment process undergoes purification, making it suitable for various purposes, including use in fire extinguishers and for landscaping. The facility also provides environmental sustainability by implementing rainwater harvesting systems. A remarkable aspect of this facility is its continuous supervision, ensuring that all operations adhere to strict quality and environmental standards.

This site visit provided the students with practical exposure to the inner workings of a waste treatment plant, imparting invaluable knowledge about sustainable waste management practices. The students were accompanied by Ms. Delisha Rebello, Assistant Professor in Commerce & Ms. Ashwini Devari Assistant Professor in Financial Services.


Ms. Pooja Shanbhag, Convenor of FDP Cell and member of Criterion 2 commenced the session by welcoming all the participants and introducing the concept of OBE. She emphasized OBE's student-centered approach, highlighting the importance of defining learning outcomes from the outset. Ms. Shanbhag explained the distinctions between POs, COs, and displayed the

previously prepared program outcomes, program-specific outcomes, and program objectives according to NAAC requirements. In addition, she explained the significance of developing clear and measurable learning outcomes for different courses and programs. She also shared some of her course outcomes of the courses/subjects taught by her. Ms. Shanbhag guided the faculty on crafting effective course outcomes and learning outcomes, incorporating Bloom's Taxonomy. She also discussed innovative pedagogies for assessing and evaluating these learning outcomes.

In the second part of the session, Mr. Andre Pacheco elucidated various mapping matrices that illustrate the correlation between COs and POs, as well as COs and PSOs. He demonstrated the process of defining, assessing, and aligning POs and COs. Mr. Pacheco highlighted a list of assessment methods and tools that can enhance the learning experience and improve overall student performance. He concluded that mapping allows educators to track the progression of learning outcomes from courses to the overall program. Faculty members had the opportunity to ask questions and seek clarifications. The session successfully provided faculty members with a clearer understanding of the application of OBE principles in their respective courses. It equipped them with strategies to enhance the quality of education through outcomes-focused approaches.

Guest Lecture on "The Future of Advertising: Trends Challenges and Innovation."


