30 Hours Certificate Course in Practical Aspects of Income Tax and GST (including Return Filing)

10th January -18th March 2024



The Post Graduate Department of Commerce organized a Certificate Course in Practical Aspects of Income Tax and GST (including Return Filing) from 10th January 2024 to 18th March 2024 in Classroom T-304 for the students of M. Com Part I between 1.30 pm to 3.30 pm (every Monday, Friday). Tuesday and The objective of the Course was to provide a practical understanding of GST Laws and Provisions to the students thereby enabling them to handle the income tax

and GST E-filing portal and online processes. The training sessions were delivered by Ms. Sonam Daivajna, Director of SDS Accosphere Advisors Pvt. Ltd., Margao.

Initially, Ms. Sonam covered various basic theoretical concepts related to Indirect Taxes and Income Tax. She explained the basic concepts of indirect taxes and the constitutional levy of GST. It included the features of indirect tax and the tax hierarchy. The types of taxes levied such as IGST, CGST, and SGST were explained with a handful of examples. Further, the students were given a clear view of the meaning and scope of supply under GST. The various exemptions to GST were elucidated.

Ms. Sonam also invited one of her acquaintances to explain thoroughly the procedure of filing Income Tax Returns online. The procedure of Registration under the GST regime was covered. She briefed us about the GST return forms available. She shed light on how residential status is determined for calculating taxable income. The concept of Advance Tax was explained. It also covered the various deductions available to taxpayers under various sections of the Income Tax Act. Each sub-topic was well explained followed by practical problems related to the topic.

The course winded up with a 180-mark assessment test for the students held on 18th March 2024 from 1.30 pm to 3.30 pm, requiring the students to obtain a minimum of 75% marks in order to obtain the course certificate. At the end of the course, students were provided a Google form link to collect their valued feedback regarding the course. 42 M. Com students benefited from the course.

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The Post-Graduate Department association with the Training, Internship, and Placement Cell organized NET/ SET Coaching in Paper II for the M. Com Part II students from 13th January 2024 to 30th March in Classroom T-302. The objective of the Coaching was to help the students in preparing in Paper II (Commerce), one of the papers to be answered to clear the NET/SET Exam, which is the eligibility requirement for the post of Assistant

Professor in Commerce. The faculty members of the P.G. Department of Commerce engaged the sessions.

2. Self-defence training session for girl students

The self-defence training session was organised for girl students on 21st February, 2024. The session aimed to empower young women with essential skills for self-protection and instil confidence in handling challenging situations. Mr. Suraj Paradekar, a renowned Karate instructor and India Book of Record holder was invited as the Resource Person for the training session. With his expertise and experience, Mr. Paradekar ensured an engaging and informative session. 20 girl students actively participated in the training session. Mr. Paradekar began with fundamental self-defence techniques, including blocking, striking, and evading potential threats. Through live demonstrations and interactive exercises, participants learned how to apply these techniques effectively in real-life situations. Beyond physical techniques, emphasis was placed on building mental strength, awareness, and self-confidence. Lastly, a question-and-answer session allowed participants to seek clarification on specific techniques and scenarios, fostering a deeper understanding of self-defence principles.

3. Stand Up, Speak Out" Workshop on Public Speaking

A Workshop titled "Stand Up, Speak Out" was organised on 22nd February, 2024. The workshop aimed to empower young women to articulate their thoughts confidently and effectively in various public settings. Ms. Kimberly Gomes, a speech and drama teacher at Vidya Vikas Academy, was invited as the Resource Person for the workshop. With her expertise in communication and performance, Ms. Gomes ensured an enriching and interactive learning experience for all participants. 40 students participated in the workshop. The workshop commenced with an introduction by the Women's Cell coordinator, emphasizing the importance of effective communication skills in personal and professional growth. Ms. Gomes then took the stage and guided participants through various aspects of public speaking. Ms. Gomes stressed the significance of understanding the audience's needs and preferences to deliver impactful speeches. Participants learned techniques for utilizing body language and voice modulation to convey confidence and conviction while speaking. Practical tips were provided on structuring speeches, including the introduction, body, and conclusion, to maintain coherence and engagement. Strategies for overcoming stage fright and nervousness were discussed, and Interactive exercises were conducted to allow participants to apply the skills in a supportive environment.

4. Women's Day Celebration: Free Dental Check-up Camp and Pink Sale

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Women's Day was celebrated on 7th March, 2024, at the College, hosting several events to commemorate the occasion.

One of the highlights was a Free Dental Check-up Camp conducted by Dr. Sayali Dinar Mardolkar and Dr. Priyanka D'Souza from Studio32 Dental Clinic. This camp provided an opportunity for both staff (teaching & non-teaching) and students of the College to receive free dental check-ups, promoting dental health awareness within the community. The camp saw active participation from 60 staff and students, emphasizing the importance of oral health. In addition to the dental camp, there was also a Pink Sale of items organized by students. This sale featured various pink-themed items to promote entrepreneurship skills among female students.

Furthermore, the Women's Day celebration took place in the College quadrangle. The program was compered by Steral Fernandes from BBA. Aastha from B. Com gave an impactful speech and other students sang a song including a special recognition ceremony where women staff (teaching & non-teaching) were felicitated by the Principal. One Day National Conference (Hybrid Mode) on Economic Transformation - a Future Perspective vis-a-vis Technology

The Department of Economics and Banking in collaboration with the Directorate of Higher Education, Government of Goa, organized a One Day National Conference (Hybrid Mode) with the theme 'Economic Transformation - A Future Perspective vis- a-vis Technology' on 24th of February, 2024.

The Inaugural session of the Conference was held in Hall No. 2 of

the Central Block, at 10.30 am. The Session began with the Invocation song and the lighting of the lamp by the dignitaries present. The compere for the Inaugural session was Asst. Professor Lizette D'Costa.

The Principal in her welcome address spoke about the changing face of the economy and said that any discussion on the economy has to include technology. She congratulated the Department of Economics for organizing the Conference on a very relevant topic.

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Mr. Shreyas Desai, the Conference Coordinator, addressed the audience. He said that today the business environment has become more dynamic and it is difficult to imagine a business without an online presence.

The Chief Guest of the Conference, Professor of Economics and Former Director IIM, Ahmedabad, Professor Errol D'Souza, was introduced by Dr. Lira Gama, Head of the Department of Economics and Banking.

Professor Errol, in his address, elaborated on the history of the growth of technology and the workings of the human mind. He gave some examples of studies conducted based on data and human wisdom. He opined that machines need a human mind to make decisions as they are not super intelligent and only work on pre-assigned data, and emphasized that we need to train the data to not be biased. He further added that automation and mechanization have considerably increased the salary earned by employees on the high end but we need to rethink our social life.

The first technical session commenced at 12.15 pm and was held in Hall no. 2. It was an offline session and the moderator was Dr. Shripad Marathe, Assistant Professor in Commerce, Swami Vivekanand College of Commerce, Borim. The compere for the session was Ms. Swati Bhat, Assistant Professor in the Department of Commerce & Management. Dr. Sheetal Arondekar, Associate Professor, introduced the moderator, and a floral welcome was extended by Assistant Professor Sheryl Sanches. Four research papers were presented during this session, covering diverse topics such as the adoption of digital marketing in the MSME sector in Goa, the necessity of state government subsidies on e-vehicles and hybrid vehicles, the perception and experience of MOOCs among college students in South Goa, and a study on global innovation capacity focusing on BRICS countries. The session concluded with remarks from the moderator, followed by the presentation of a memento by Mr. Ainsley Bernard, Assistant Professor in Commerce. The first session witnessed research scholars presenting papers and shedding light on cutting-edge developments and the transformative impact of technology and their applications in different domains.

The second technical session started at 2:30 pm in Hall No. 2, with Mr. Yasser Hussain Razak, Assistant Professor in Economics at MES Vasant Joshi College of Arts & Commerce, Zuarinagar, chairing the session. The compere for this session was Ms. Marjina Shaikh, Asst. Professor in Commerce & Management. Ms. Saruka Kalangutkar, Assistant Professor in Economics, introduced the moderator, and Assistant Professor Delisha Rebello, presented a floral welcome. Like the first session, this was also an in-person event featuring four research paper presentations on various themes, such as the evaluation of the performance of AI stocks in India, the Role of Technology in women empowerment, empirical testing of capital asset pricing model in India, and understanding financial inclusions amongst the unorganized workforce in Goa. The session concluded with the Moderators' remarks followed by the presentation of the memento by Ms. Kalpana Parab, Assistant Professor in Commerce.

The third technical session was a parallel session held in online mode in the Smart Classroom, Ground floor. The Moderator of this session was Dr. Rodney D'Silva, Associate Professor in Commerce. Asst. Professor Pretty Pereira was the compere for this session and the Moderator was introduced by Asst. Professor, Dr. Monica Patil. A total of five papers on topics of Digital transformation, Digitalisation of Payments, Inclusivity in HSS, the Role of technology in disaster management, and the future of start-ups, were presented during this session. The session concluded with the Moderator's remarks and he congratulated all the presenters for their active participation. The session concluded with the presentation of a memento by Ms. Akshada Gaonkar, Assistant Professor in Commerce.

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The Valedictory session commenced at 4:15 pm in Hall No. 2, with Dr. Maithili Naik, Assistant Professor in Commerce, serving as the compere. The esteemed Chief Guest for the occasion was Dr. Kaustubh Kamat, Assistant Director of Academics at the Directorate of Higher Education. Dr. Prita Mallya, Professor, and Principal extended a warm welcome to the Chief guest by presenting a potted plant. Mr. Sanjay Velip, the Conference Coordinator, then proceeded to read the proceedings of the one-day National conference titled 'Economic Transformation - A Future Perspective Vis-a-vis Technology,' conducted in Hybrid Mode.

options in Cost & Management accounting and provide them with career guidance in this field.



The primary objective was to provide entrepreneurial insights and shed light on career opportunities in the field of agriculture and farming. The distinguished Resource Person for the session was Mr. Varad Samant, a young Agripreneur and Owner of Samant Agro Farm, Dabal-Dharbandoda, Goa.

Mr. Samant commenced the session by sharing his personal entrepreneurial journey in agriculture, detailing the challenges, milestones, and transformative experiences that shaped his success. He elaborated on the various crops, vegetables, and farm produce cultivated, emphasizing the cultivation patterns and the journey from a small trial to large-scale farming with diverse crops. He told students that he continuously implements innovation and creative ideas in the field of agriculture.

The speaker delved into various innovative practices and technologies that he implemented in his farms. This included discussions on precision farming, sustainable practices, and the integration of technology in optimizing crop yield and resource utilization. A significant portion of the session was dedicated to analysing current market trends and identifying opportunities in the agriculture sector.

Mr. Varad highlighted the profits available in this field, emphasizing that a considerable portion of his farm produce is procured by the Goa Horticulture Department and sold through individual horticulture kiosks across the state. The lecture by Mr. Varad Samant provided students with valuable knowledge, innovative ideas, and motivation to explore entrepreneurial opportunities in the agricultural sector. 66 students attended the session. The faculty in charge for planning and organising the session were Assistant Professor Ms. Namrata Ugvekar, Ms. Kalpana Parab, Ms. Prashanti Bhamaikar and Ms. Pooja Shanbhag from B. Com Programme.

Field Trip to Tangentia India Technologies (Pvt) Ltd and an Exhibition at National Space Science Symposium

1st March 2024



The Department of Computer Science organized a Field Trip on 1st March 2024 to Tangentia India Technologies (Pvt) Ltd., Panjim and to the Exhibition at National Space Science Symposium 2024 (NSSS 2024) at Goa University campus. The objective of the field trip was to provide students with insights into the operations and functioning of an IT company. The visit aimed to enhance students' understanding of real-world applications of technology, industry trends, and career opportunities in the IT sector.

The students were briefed about the company by Ms. Sonia Kuncalienker, Regional Sales Manager at Tangentia. She highlighted that Tangentia is a Canada based IT company leading in Autonomous Digital Transformation, besides being one of the leading providers of AI services, helping companies harness the power of AI. The company has been offering service and sales for more than 20 years, since its inception in 2003. Besides its offices in Goa, it has spread across Bangalore, Mumbai and Delhi, America and Mexico.

Ms. Kuncalienker, also focused on the practices followed by Tangentia namely, Intelligent Automation, Supply Chain and Tangentia Intelligent Automation (TiA). Intelligent Automation basically deals with Artificial Intelligence, Robotic Process Automation (RPA) and Process Mining Management. Under Supply Chain the company handles Electronic Data Interchange (EDI), B2B and B2C E-Commerce and IBM Sterling. TiA is the proprietary product of Tangentia and has been developed over a period of research by the company. The TiA Industry Accelerator (TiA IA) which is part of the TiA Platform has been built to serve the needs of various industries such as banking, pharmaceutical and manufacturing, offering deployment-ready software solutions built to accelerate business processes. Its capabilities can be extended, modified or customized, depending on the individual needs of the company, making it the ideal solution for process automation.

As the session progressed, Ms. Kuncalienker mentioned the 4P Delivery Model followed by the company, which basically expands to People, Project, Platforms and Partner. The company is also a certified partner with Software giants like Google and Microsoft.

As the session concluded, Ms. Kuncalienker shared one of Tangentia's success story that was shared by Nations Translation Group – the ability to harness the power of IBM WDG RPA technology in order to create a bot that reads emails in real-time, extracts key info from documents, and updates Bridgeterm, the request tracking software. As a result, emails are now attended to promptly, no more missed requests, and users have real-time access to status reports.

The QA session followed wherein students put forth questions related to the soft skill requirement, the various opportunities in an IT sector, and about internships offered by Tangentia in Robotic Process Automation. Positive

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feedback for the session was provided by Anushree Shirodkar from FY BCA and Joel Fernandes from SY BCA. The SYBCA students also discussed their project ideas and got an insight into learning the right technology to take their project ahead in their final year.

A visit to the Exhibition at National Space Science Symposium 2024 got the students an opportunity to interact with Mr. Satyendra Kumar, a PhD Student from IIT Kanpur, who explained in brief about the role of technology in the context of the Chandrayaan Mission and also provided a reference to see the Moon and its craters for exploration in that area.

The faculty In-charge for the field trip were Ms. Annette Santimano and Ms. Sweta Verenkar. 37 students from the BCA and B.Voc.(ST) programmes benefited from the field trip. Students gave very positive feedback about the trip as it was also a requirement given by students to the Mentoring Cell for organizing more field trips.

Research Workshop Series – II (Primary Data Analysis using IBM – SPSS)

2nd - 9th March 2024



The Research Workshop Series – II was organized by the Post Graduate Department of Commerce (M. Com) on 2nd & 9th March 2024. The aim was to equip M. Com Part I & II students with the skills to handle, analyse, and interpret data using SPSS.

The first session was held on 2nd March 2024 in the Smart Classroom. Dr. Kaustabh Kamat, Assistant Director, was the Resource Person for the session introducing the audience to the basics of primary data analysis. He started off the session with the basics in research that included briefing the students on research objectives, types of errors, hypotheses and significance level. The session covered different types of variables, how they can be coded in SPSS, measures of central tendency like mean, median, and mode, the concept of skewness, and how to create a box plot in SPSS.

The second session was held on 9th March 2024 in Classroom No. T-302. The session commenced at 1:30 p.m. and covered advanced topics in data analysis. The session emphasized that a lower standard deviation is desirable as it indicates that the data points are closer to the mean. It also covered the independent sample t-test, parametric tests, Analysis of Variance (ANOVA), non-parametric tests, the Kruskal Wallis test, the chi-square test, Impulsive Response Test along with their interpretation and an introduction to factor analysis. Both sessions ended at 4:30 p.m.

These sessions provided the students with a practical understanding on IBM-SPSS software and was a significant step towards enabling the students to effectively use SPSS for data analysis in their research papers.

The students were also shown the process of bee-keeping and honey extraction as well as the different techniques of organic farming carried out in the farm.

The students had a pleasant learning experience. Later, the students went around exploring the eco-friendly cottages and mud houses built as part of sustainable tourism. 44 students visited the farm. 

The entire recording was guided by our Alumnus Ms Shakuntala Bharne, Senior Announcer at Akashwani Panaji.


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Awareness Quiz "Consumer Protection Act 2019"

During the workshop, the students were introduced to Scrum Project Management using the Jira tool. Mr. Chetan Rane explained the purpose & use of the Jira tool and the different roles involved in a software development project. As it was a hands-on session, the students could create new projects, enter the tasks and manage it. Mr. Rane also explained details on how to track web elements on a website and analyse them. Furthermore, the concept of functional decomposition of a Website Homepage and identifying of elements was demonstrated.

The concept of assigning Points for tasks and allotting it to project team members according to their abilities and availability of tools was shown with an example. Mr. Chetan Rane explained the fundamental concepts of identifying and categorizing tasks and elements as Epic, Story, Tasks and sub tasks.

The session focused on Scrum Project management, the concept of Scrum ceremonies, retrospection and sprints with real project examples handled by the Resource Person. Creating a Sprint and assigning Story points to developers during a sprint was explained. Tracking of a Sprint's progress and reporting using Charts for Project Tasks was also shown.

The Resource Person explained a live application of a company and its Jira interface to understand the use of Jira in Industry. Students interacted with the Resource Person with their queries and answers throughout the session. It was a very interactive and informative session for the students as the Jira tool can be used for their TY Projects. Furthermore, the workshop was also a part of evaluation for an Assignment in the relevant Courses.

including the art and elements of first impression, how to write a good CV, skills necessary to stand out during an interview, high performance communication, power of body language, types of body postures while sitting and standing – which ones to adopt and which to avoid, types of handshakes, importance of elevator pitch, types of clothes, shoes, perfume to be perfect on the day of the interview, art of departing and most importantly how to confidently answer an interview.
