 - a. Section A Quantitative Aptitude 15 Questions
 - b. Section B Logical Reasoning 15 Questions
 - c. Section C Computer Awareness 10 Questions
 - d. Section D General Knowledge 10 Questions

B. Tie-Breaking Rules –

After considering all the weightage components together, if the merit rank of students are in the situation of tie, then the merit rank to be decided based on the rules mentioned below.

The following rules to be applied in the order given below when there is a tie -

- 1) Student having higher score in the **Entrance Test component** shall be ranked higher.
- 2) Student having higher score in the **12th Marks component** shall be ranked higher.
- 3) Student having higher score in the **Section B: Logical Reasoning** of the Aptitude Test component shall be ranked higher.
- 4) Student having higher score in the **Section A: Quantitative Aptitude** of the Aptitude Test component shall be ranked higher.
- 5) Student having higher score in the **Section C: Computer Awareness** of the Aptitude Test component shall be ranked higher.
- 6) Student having higher score in the **Section D: General Knowledge** of the Aptitude Test component shall be ranked higher.
- 7) If the tie still exists, then the decision will be taken by the Admission committee of the respective college and the same to be indicated in the ranking list.
