

**COLLEGE COUNCIL ELECTION
CODE OF CONDUCT FOR CANDIDATES**


In order to ensure that the College Elections are conducted in a fair, peaceful, and respectful manner, all student candidates are required to strictly adhere to the following code of conduct:

1. **Respectful and Regulated Campaigning:** All campaigning must be conducted respectfully, focusing on the candidate's vision and plans. Negative campaigning, personal attacks, use of offensive language, or spreading false information is prohibited. Campaigning is allowed only during times allotted by the Election Committee.
2. **No Post-Election Rallies:** Candidates and their supporters shall not organise or participate in any rallies, victory processions, or loud celebrations within the campus premises after the declaration of results.
3. **Prohibition of Violence and Misconduct:** Physical or verbal fights, intimidation, harassment, or any form of unruly behaviour towards other candidates, students, or staff are strictly prohibited.
4. **No Photography of Results:** Candidates and students are not permitted to take photographs, screenshots, or videos of the results displayed in classrooms, notice boards, or official platforms.
5. **Graceful Acceptance of Results:** All candidates must accept the election outcome with dignity, avoid disruptive behaviour, and extend full cooperation to the Election Committee for the smooth completion of the process.

Note: Any violation of the above points will attract strict disciplinary action, including possible disqualification from the election.
