

A total of 161 people answered the quiz, and 70 received the e-certificates.



Report on Teacher's Day Celebration and Gurukul Activity


5th September 2020

a unique way. The activity concluded at 5.00 pm. 26 students and 3 faculty members attended the programme.


Teachers' Day Virtual Celebration



Orientation Programme for M.Com Part1 Students


9th September 2020




experience at Shree Damodar College, as the College emphasizes not only on imparting quality education but also focuses on the overall development of students.





Health Check-Up 16th September 2020



Vidya Vikas Mandal institutions participated in the program. Of these, 2 staff members were from GR Kare College of Law, 1 staff member was from Vidya Vikas Academy, 10 staff members were from RMS Higher Secondary School, and 15 staff members were from Shree Damodar College.

The Health checkup aimed at recording the health status of the subjects before conducting the Fitness Program, scheduled for 12 weeks, which will include Strength training and Cardio training. All participants were tested for their Weight, Height, BMI, BMR, Body Fat Percentage, Blood Pressure and Blood Lipids level. Dr. Venkatesh P. Hegde conducted the Blood Lipids and Blood Pressure

and Multidisciplinary Education.


