



Tech Talk -Peer To Peer Teaching Learning



28th November 2020

The Department of Computer Science conducted a Tech Talk for the students of FYBCA as a part of Peer-to-Peer teaching learning. FYBCA student Mr. Yashodhan Sawadekar conducted the session on Git Hub, which is widely used by developers. The session was held on 28th November 2020 from 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.

Through his well-organized presentation, Mr. Yashodhan explained to his fellow mates what the Git open-source version control system is, and through a practical demonstration, explained how it helps developers to make constant changes to the code.

He explained that Git is a command-line tool and the centre around which all things involving Git revolve; it is the hub, where developers store their projects. He elaborated upon how it helps to network with like-minded people. He demonstrated how GitHub can be used to store projects and how a team working on a project can collaborate and handle project revisions.

The session was very practical and students were able to understand how they can use GitHub effectively for their practical courses.

The 86 FYBCA students, who were present, appreciated the session. Faculty members Mr. Sumit Kumar and Ms. Akshada Hegde congratulated Mr. Yashodhan for his able handling of the topic.

The session ended with Ms. Namita Neurenkar, the faculty in-charge appreciating and thanking Mr. Yashodhan for making a very informative practical presentation. She informed students that during a mentoring session, Yashodhan had revealed that he was using GitHub, and the Department thought of organizing the session. She explained that Tech Talk – Peer-to-Peer Teaching-Learning aims to provide students with a platform to share what they know with others, and in the process evolve as confident young individuals.

Guest Lecture on Materials Management

28th November 2020

The PG Department organized a guest lecture in Materials Management for M.Com students on November 28th, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. The Resource Person was Ms. Radha Shinkre, Director, Sincro Hotels Pvt Ltd, Goa. The session began with the introduction of the resource person. Ms. Radha Shinkre completed her degree in the food industry at the Culinary Arts Academy in Switzerland. She completed her internship in Dubai at the JW Mariott Marquis, and continued to work at JW Mariott Marquis for 2 years before coming back to Goa and taking charge of Sincro Hotels. Her intensive internship and experience gained at JW Mariott Marquis helped her to handle the business in Goa. At JW Mariott Marquis, she had learnt to cater to 3000 to 4000 customers a day.

During her session, Ms. Shinkre mainly focused on kitchen inventory, which are mostly perishable and thus the need to store them properly and use various inventory management techniques to ensure proper utilization of resources.

Being in the food business, Ms. Shinkre stated that preparing the exact quantity is not possible, but can be estimated based on the day of the week. For example, one can expect more orders during the weekend than on weekdays.

Proper handling and storage of materials is very important to ensure the profitability of the business. For this purpose, she said she personally takes stock of the material at the end of the day and decides what needs to be purchased the next day. She believes in Supplier Development and Partnering and thus personally buys the supplies from her local vendor to check for freshness and quality. Certain groceries that can be purchased in bulk such as rice and dal, are purchased at a discount.

One should understand that the cost of the product is greatly influenced by the cost of the raw material. Thus, purchasing the material at the right price and quality is essential to the business.

The 48 students who attended had an interactive session on Materials Management. The session ended with the vote of thanks by Ms. Stacy Pereira of M.Com Part II.



The Department of Computer Science organised Online Training sessions in Module N9002 requirements of the Qualification Pack for Junior Software Developer (JSD) from 30th November to 7th December, 2020. 

Good verbal and written communication skills are essential in order to deliver and understand information quickly and accurately. Being able to communicate is an important life skill and should not be overlooked. Higher educational and professional workspaces require effective communication skills. 




Guest Lecture on 'Business Environment and International Trade/ Marketing Management'



Online Session on 'Career Prospects in Insurance Sector'



The session ended at 1.15 pm. 30 students participated in the session.




Guest Lecture on 'Strategic Management'



Ms. Sanchia Da Costa student of FYBBA(FS) B proposed the Vote of Thanks. The session ended at 12.30 pm after a Q&A round.



to 10th December, 2020. The objective of the quiz was to provide an Open quiz to all individuals in various age groups for information sharing and learning through the options provided in every question.






Webinar on "Opportunities in the Banking Sector"

14th December 2020




Assistant Professor Ms. Pretty Pereira welcomed the Resource Person followed by the introduction of the resource person.


Ms. Minoska Fernandes, student from FY B.Com B delivered the Vote of thanks.


Paper Presentation on 'Industry 4.0/5.0 - Getting Our Graduates Ready'
